## Subject: Minutes of the Meeting of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Level Committee held on 05.11.2019 for consideration of proposals for utilization of funds during the FY 2019-20 under 1% Incremental Revenue Scheme -reg.

A meeting of the 2<sup>nd</sup> level Committee of three Directors General was held on 05.11.2019 under the Chairmanship of Shri A K Pandey, Member (P&A) & Special Secretary holding charge of Principal Director General, DGGI, for consideration of proposals for utilization of funds during the FY 2019-20 under 1% Incremental Revenue Scheme. A copy of the 'Minutes of the Meeting' is enclosed herewith for kind reference. All the proposals which are covered by the scope of the scheme were considered as per para (3) of the Minutes but the types of proposals which are not covered by the scheme and thus were not considered are listed in Annexure – 'B' where comments regarding possible alternate source of funding are provided.

2. It is heartening that there is a proposal to provide two wheelers/motorcycles with a ceiling of Rs. 70,000/- per item to all the CGST formations and DoL will formulate the proposal in this regard.

3. It is also heartening to let you know that the scheme for providing laptops is proposed to be extended to Group B officers posted in CGST formations & Directorates. While the requirement of GST formation will be assessed by DoL, for the requirement of the Directorates this office has earlier vide letter of even no. 5772-86 dated 08.11.2019 requested to provide the Sanctioned Strength and Working Strength. As officers on loan from GST will be already accounted, the working strength shall not include the same. This may be sent at the earliest as DoL have been asked to submit proposal in a fortnight's time. DoL will formulate the proposal in this regard.

4. In respect of the Customs preventive formations it is now been proposed to cover the remaining formations (where we have not earlier provided), to provide two wheelers/ motorcycles to all Customs preventive ranges, divisions & Commissionerates. The requirement may also vary depending on terrain. You are, therefore, requested to forward details regarding their availability and future requirements along with justification, Customs (Preventive) range-wise and sector-

wise. Approximate cost may also be provided. The requisite information may please be provided as Annexure – I.

5. The Committee observed that there are sufficient funds and the same is not being released as proposals appropriate for consideration under the scheme are not being received from the field formations and proposals which are not covered under 1% scheme are being received (suggestion under Annexure 'B' may be referred). The scope of 1% Incremental Revenue Scheme is to work out relevant schemes/proposals based on the principle of enhanced provisions for augmenting operational efficiency arising out of the incremental revenues earned beyond the budget targets on the basis of following guidelines:

- "Schemes should be formulated for improving the permanent infrastructure or assets and intended towards long-term benefits of the Department.
- Schemes which are basically consumption oriented and recurring in nature should be avoided".

6. The Directorates are requested to forward information at para (3) by 25.11.2019 so as to formulate the proposal. Further information at para (4) and fresh proposals in tune with the scheme and as informed at para (5) by the first week of December, 2019 so that the same may be taken up by the next meeting scheduled in December, 2019.

Subject: Minutes of the meeting of the 2<sup>nd</sup> level Committee, headed by Principal Director General DG GST Intelligence held on 05.11.2019 for consideration of proposals for utilization of funds under 1 % Incremental Revenue Scheme for FY 2019-20.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Level Committee constituted for utilization of funds under 1% Incremental Revenue Scheme, met on 05-11-2019 in the North Block under the Chairmanship of Shri A K Pandey, Member (P&A) & Special Secretary holding charge of Principal Director General, DGGI, in his chamber to consider recommendations of the 1<sup>st</sup> level Committee regarding proposals for utilization of funds under 1 % Incremental Revenue Scheme for FY 2019-20. Following members of the Committee were present :

As per provisions contained in Para 5 of the department of Expenditures O.M. No. 7(3)E-2. Coord/2006 dated 22-07-2006 schemes could be evolved by the revenue generating / earning /collecting Ministries/Departments on the principal of an amount equal to 1% of the incremental revenue being earmarked as incentive provision for enhancing the organizational efficiency, infrastructure and wherewithal. Pursuant thereto, an amount of Rs 498.22 crores representing 1% of incremental revenue earned during 2005-06 (Rs 71.42 crores ); 2006-07 (Rs. 113.63 crores) and 2010-11 ( Rs. 313.17 crores) was sanctioned to the CBIC with the approval Honorable Finance Minister as during these years the revenue collection had exceeded the BE targets. Efforts are being made, for the subsequent years when CBIC exceeded the revenue targets, to get credit of additional funds under 1% Incremental Revenue Scheme as per entitlement. Out of the total amount of Rs. 498.22 crores received since 2006-07, Department has been able to utilize an amount of Rs. 296.6933 crore up to the end of FY 2018-19, leaving a balance of Rs. 201.5267 crore (Encl:1). From this balance, an amount of Rs. 20 crore has been budgeted under the scheme for the current FY 2019-20. During the FY 2019-20, out of Rs. 20 Crore budgeted, an amount of Rs. 15.15 crore has been earmarked for revalidation for making payments for the proposals approved during the FY 2017-18 and FY 2018-19. The revalidation status for the same are detailed in Encl:2. After the

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revalidations for proposals sanctioned in 2017-18 and 2018-19, a balance amount of about Rs. 4.85 crores is available with CBIC for sanction of new proposals in F.Y. 2019-20. Accordingly, the Directorate of Logistics had initiated the process of consultation with the CBIC formations for formulation of new proposals for improved and timely utilization of funds under 1% Incremental Revenue Scheme for the FY 2019-20. DoL has received many proposals from CBIC formations for consideration under 1% incremental revenue scheme including those which are not covered under the scheme related to purchase of XBIS Machines, setting up of Gymnasium, Videoscope, Smart Mobile phones, Indoor sports building etc. All these proposals were scrutinised and harmonised by the 1<sup>st</sup> level Committee one by one for their suitability for consideration. After detailed deliberations the 1<sup>st</sup> level committee during its meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019 ( copy of Minutes of the Meeting enclosed), recommended 25 proposals involving a total estimated Expenditure of Rs. 4.827 Crore, as per Annexure 'A' for consideration by the 2<sup>nd</sup> level committee under 1% incremental revenue scheme.

After comprehensive discussions, the proposals listed below with the amount mentioned 3. against them, have been considered by the 2<sup>nd</sup> level Committee. The details of the proposals with complete justification are provided in Annexure 'A'. The Committee noted that the amount sanctioned in previous years has not been fully utilised and hence many revalidations are carried out in subsequent years. It may be possible that the total sanctioned amount may not be fully spent during FY 2019-20 and that there are Rs. 201.5267 Crore (Encl. 1) available in balance, thus as recommended by the 1st level committee that apart from approvals of "Total Estimated Cost" granted, an additional recommendation for release of funds as per "Expected Expenditure in FY 2019-20" were considered by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Level Committee and approved. Thus the "Total Estimated Cost" of the proposal is being recommended by the Committee for approval as per Column 3 and the recommendations of the Committee for release of funds in FY 2019-20 as per "Expected Expenditure in FY 2019-20" is shown in Column 4 of the table below. The corresponding Sl. No. of proposal in Annexure "A" is also mentioned at Column 2. Accordingly, the total amount reflected in Column 4 of the table below is within the limit of Rs 20 crore budget earmarked for the FY 2019-20 under 1% incremental revenue scheme and is expected to be spent in FY 2019-20. Accordingly, these 25 proposals may be sent to the Ministry for release of funds. Here the Committee also accepted the recommendation of the 1st level Committee that the Motorcycles for CGST formations should be restricted to @ Rs70,000/- per motorcycle.

4. Therefore proposals recommended by the 1st Level Committee, in its meeting held on 30.09.2019, as per details above, involving a total estimated Expenditure of Rs. 4.827 Crore in 25 proposals, have been approved by the 2nd Level Committee.

5. The 1st level Committee had also noted that several proposals from the GST formations are being received for the purchase of motor cycles for use by the executive officers to carry out their official functions like patrolling, reconnaissance, verifications, evidence collection during investigations, delivering summons, Show Cause Notices , including e-waybill verifications, delivering various communications/documents, movement in difficult terrains etc. Therefore, 1st level Committee suggested that the requirement of motor cycles by the GST formations may be taken up through a consolidated proposal rather than considering the cases in piecemeal manner. So the Committee deliberated the recommendation to sanction one Motorcycle for each GST Range, audit party and two per Divisional or Audit Circle office and five for Commissionerate (Executive & Audit) and approved the same. DoL shall move a consolidated proposal to the Board in this regard. The requirement of Customs Preventive Commissionerates for the motor cycles is already been considered by DoL from 1% Scheme in routine manner. However the DoL may write to the Customs Preventive Commissionerates in this regard with a view to strengthen them.

6. The Committee further deliberated that after implementation of GST and automation of functions under e-governance strategy of the Government of India, several functions at GST Range level and in CBIC Directorates are needed to be carried out in field itself necessitating requirement of laptops. The officers of GST sector, range, divisional, audit circle, anti-evasion, technical, legal sections are required to do a lot of storage of data, comparisons, verifications, data analytics etc. along with retrieving huge information on the move and in the field for revenue compliance while being mobile. Similarly, all the Directorates ( DG ARM, DG Audit, DGEP, DG GSTI, DG GST, DG HRD, DG HRM, NACIN, DGPM, DGRI, DG Safeguards, DG Systems & Data Management, DG Taxpayer Services, DG Valuation, DG Vigilance, DIC, DoL, DLA ) have to cater to the increased need of field formations and meet with the expectations of Board in an expedited manner. Therefore, in order for the GST formations and Directorate officers to have access to latest technology, data and information, the Committee suggested that all the Group B officers

Gazetted & non-Gazetted) in GST Commissionerates and CBIC Directorates may be provided with laptops. Initially officers in the rank of Additional Assistant Director/Superintendents may be provided the laptops and at next stage officers in the rank of Inspectors may be considered. The DoL shall after computation of requirements as per number of officers and as some laptops have already been provided to the Directorates, may come up again before this Committee within a fortnight's time.

7. The Chairman directed that DoL shall move these 25 approved proposals at the topmost priority so that the funds under 1% incremental revenue scheme for 2019-20 are timely utilised. DoL shall submit proposals for motorcycles to the Board and the proposal of laptops to this Committee in a fortnight's time and accordingly the provisions may be made in the BE 2020-21 by the DGHRD.
