Sub: Nomination of Candidates for the training as Detector Dog Handlers at Customs K9 Center, Attari, Amritsar in next batch - reg.

Madam/Sir,

It is to inform that Customs K9 Center, Amritsar was established in Feb 2020 and the training of dog handlers is being imparted on regular basis at the Center. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd batch of K9 units has already passed out and deployed at various customs formations. Fourth batch of K9 units is undergoing training at Customs K9 Center, Amritsar.

2. Further, this Directorate is in the process of selecting candidates for training in the next batch of dog handlers to be commenced in future at the Customs K9 Center, Amritsar. In this regard, following points may be noted:
 - a. The nominated candidates, after selection, will undergo induction training at Customs K9 center, Amritsar for 09 months including a mid-term preparatory visit of 15 days. During this period of 15 days the dog handlers will be on deputation to the office of final deployment for preparatory work at the formation. The handlers will move under a movement order issued by the Customs K9 Center, Attari, and report back to the CCC on completion of the mid-term preparatory visit. After completion of successful training, the handlers and dogs (K9 Unit) will be deployed at various Customs formations.
 - b. The place of posting after training will be decided by the Directorate of Logistics (DOL). The handlers from Customs formations will be deployed preferably at the same formations; however, the handlers from GST zones/Directorates will be deployed at the same station, nearby station or the choice given by them out of the available stations, as far as possible.
 - c. The Custom K9 Training Center at Attari, Amritsar has developed into a

world-class facility. The Training Center has modern infrastructure including dedicated hostels for trainees, secured training ground, training mess, lecture halls, canteen, open gym etc.

3. It may be noted that an Undertaking/Bond (Format attached **Encl 1**) is required to be signed by the willing candidate(s) for the post of Dog Handler. The original undertaking/bond shall be kept with jurisdictional formations and a copy of the same will be sent to this office.
4. It is also informed that as the training of dogs is done along with the handlers, the detector dogs will be allotted only to those Customs formations that forward the nominations of their staff for training as detector dog handler as per the allocation plan (**Encl 2**).
5. It is pertinent to mention here that CBIC in future, has requirement of around 100 K9 units for all sensitive locations across India.
6. In view of the above, you are requested to give wide publicity among the staff under your jurisdictions and to motivate them to join the Customs K9 squad. The nominations of willing candidates (irrespective of their present cadre) may be forwarded to this office as per the bio-data format enclosed (**Encl 3**) at the earliest.
7. This letter may be treated as an open circular for submitting nominations of the willing candidates for training as detector dog handlers and their candidature will be considered as and when the vacancy arises in the subsequent batches.

3. Whereas I have learnt and understood all the duties and responsibilities of Dog handler as prescribed in *Indian Customs K9 Manual* and which I was taught during the induction training and agree to serve the Department with full integrity and honesty. I also understand that I am working at a responsible position as Dog handler and any misconduct or wrong action on my part whether deliberately or otherwise which could adversely affect the performance of K9 squad or effect the health of the accompanied Canine, I shall be solely responsible.

4. And WHEREAS for the better protection of the Government I have agreed to execute this Bond with such conditions as hereunder is written:

NOW THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN OBLIGATION IS THAT, as a dog handler, in the event of my failing to discharge duty or withdrawing or resigning or voluntary retiring from service or otherwise quitting service without returning to duty after the expiry or termination of the period of sanctioned leave, as admissible or failing to complete the tenure of duty of 9 years except in the event of my death, I shall forthwith pay to the Department/ DoL or as may be directed by the Department/ DoL, the amount of any special allowance/ incentive given to me as Dog handler along with interest thereon, as applicable.
